Sailing Club

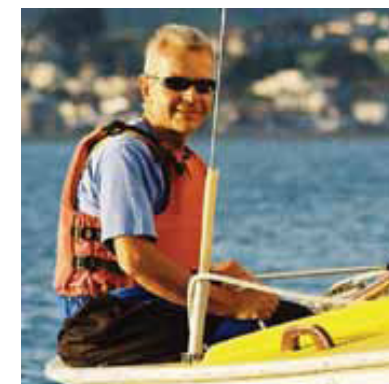

All taster sessions are for half a day. Or try both to make it a full day. Great fun!

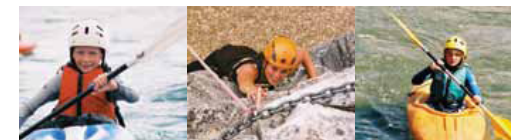
